Rushden Primary Academy analyse data to identify which pupils are underachieving and why and which interventions are most successful. The money is then allocated to support the core areas of literacy and numeracy; we know what we want to achieve from our interventions and evaluate the progress regularly.

Intervention	Amount & % of allocated PP spend	Description and Objective of Expenditure	Impact
To appoint a part time intervention teacher	£15000 approx	To ensure that the children receive specific interventions to facilitate desired progress outcomes	This will ensure the children make progress in line with non PP children
To pay for the use of a SALT professional to work with individual children	£2500 approx	Children with specific SALT needs are supported and make accelerated progress	This will ensure the children with speech and language barriers make good progress



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Funding allocated for PP/E6 children via a PP Passport, to purchase uniform, spend on the Book Fair (£30 limit), pay for clubs and enrichment. Enrichment activities for the children including: visitors, visits and Residential trips.	£100 per child £1600 total	To provide pupils with real-life experiences outside of the classroom which they would not otherwise have the opportunity to do. This will enrich the curriculum and inspire deeper learning. To ensure the PP children are smartly dressed for school	Children make good progress as engaged in curriculum.
To purchase resources that will specifically help individuals with their learning	£2000 approx	To provide the children with resources that will remove any potential barriers to learning	Children have access to resources to aid learning regardless of family economic circumstances. This will ensure the children make progress in line with non PP children
