- The Designer Art Competition for children and young adults up to the age of 18 across Rushden is part of our year long heritage project “1918-2018, Then & Now” ending with a celebratory event on Sunday 11th November 2018 commemorating 100 years of remembrance.
- Entrants are being asked to produce a “**unique pin badge for the Rushden Branch Royal British Legion’s Poppy Appeal**” of their own interpretation. This can be using paint, crayons, pencils or other craft items.
Please note due to copyright a 2 petal poppy is not to be used.
- Entrants are asked to only use size A4 paper or card so that as many as possible can be displayed for the event.
- Artwork should be clearly marked on the back with the name of the artist, their age and contact information.
- Final judging by the Mayor of Rushden and local Legion members will be on March 29th 2018.
- **The 5 top winners will have their badges produced ready for the 2018 poppy appeal. The winners will be presented with their produced badge, certificate and a £15 voucher.**
- PLEASE **SUBMIT YOUR ARTWORK NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 9th MARCH 2018.**
