Proposed Expenditure	Estimated Cost	Impact
Learning/ Family Mentor support to help overcome specific barriers and to offer family/ parent support where necessary	£2500	The FSW has been able to work closely with some of our PP families. This has resulted in improved attendance and better outcomes for the children. Action: to continue to offer support for our most vulnerable families
Financial support to ensure access to school trips, visits, extra-curricular activities, books and uniform	£1200	All children were able to access trips regardless of economic factors. Financial records show that some PP families used the money to purchase uniform and children's books from the book fair. Action: To continue to offer this service but improve communication so all PP families know what is available to them
Funded places to breakfast and after school club to support attendance, punctuality and ensure the child has received breakfast and is ready to learn	£500	Some of our children attended the B&AS provision but this has tended to be on a one off basis rather than a prearranged booking
Additional teacher support to provide targeted interventions for specific pupils in all year groups	£9000	We were able to offer specific interventions to ensure good outcomes. It is difficult to

		identify any trends in the data due to low PP numbers
Resources to support individualised programmes	£500	Action: Continue to provide useful resources but identify individual needs early in September.
