gain a deep understanding about place value up to 100. We will read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words. We will use our number bonds to 10 and add and subtract ones and tens.



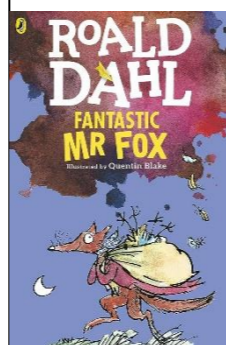
**As scientists we will...**
