As scientists we will be... exploring sound. We will look at how sound is created and how it travels to our ears. Following this, we will explore sound insulation and volume and pitch.

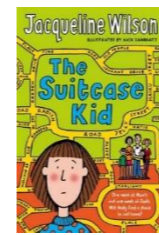

Science Home Project: This will be displayed on the hall on Friday 14th March.



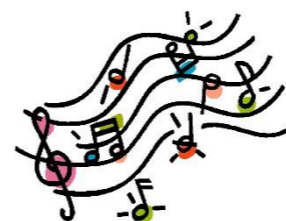
