Spelling Shed has four aims:



Choose a list



Play with friends



Beat your score



Be the best

It's very much like Reading Eggs and Sumdog! It's child friendly and allows children to progress and be challenged with their spelling in line with the National Curriculum but also with their own class spellings.

Every child has a log in that will be coming home on Friday (21st September). They can then rush home and access Spelling Shed using their browser.

Children cannot play anymore games until the assignment is completed!



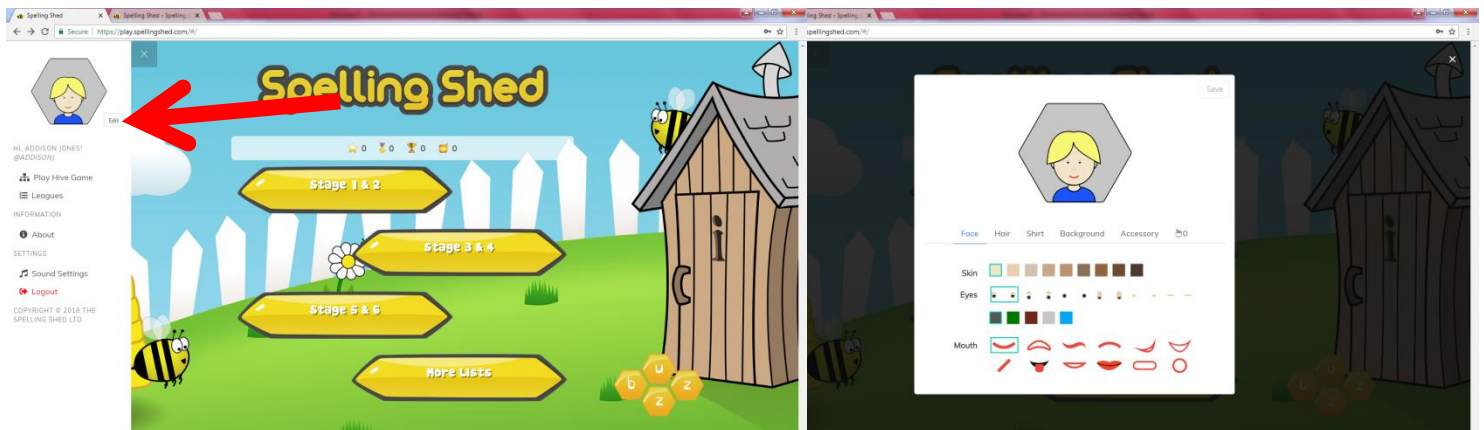
Hive Games
