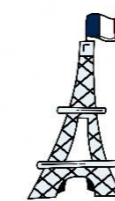
As artists we will...

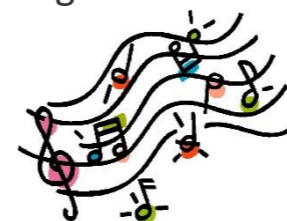
In French we will...
