learn about what volcanoes are and where they are in the world. We will focus on the parts of a volcano and what happens when they erupt.

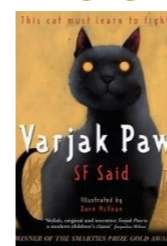

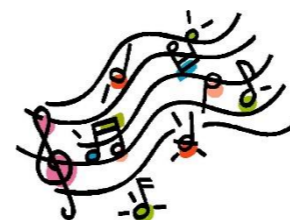
**As athletes we will...**
