create repeating patterns using watercolours by experimenting with tertiary colours using a range of brushes and techniques to create different effects.

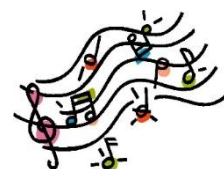


look at the importance of Christmas in the Christian faith and we will decide whether Christmas is a festival of light or love.
