be exploring and understanding Muslim beliefs, relating this to the Five Pillars of Islam, and how it affects their day-to-day lives.



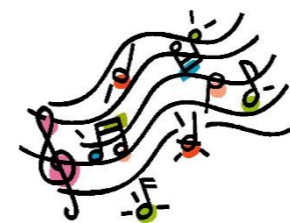
As athletes we will...
