Our focus skill for this term will be:



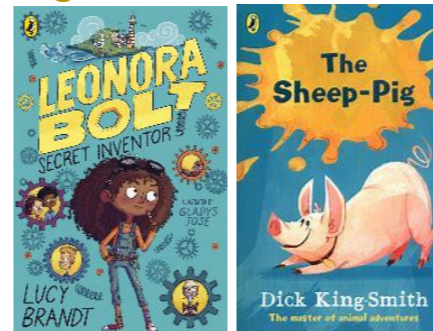
**As Technicians we will...**

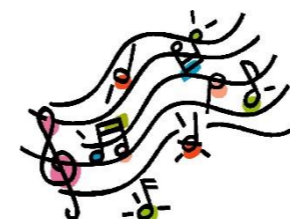


**In Religious Education we will...**
