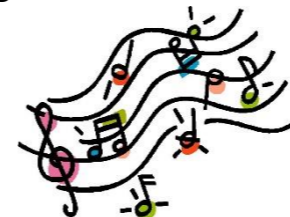
**As dancers we will...**
