













<p>As writers we will...</p> <p>create a newspaper report about missing acorns from the book, 'The Promise.' Our grammar focus will be on direct and indirect speech, 3_ed sentences and complex sentences. We will then move on to writing a description about a character from the Spiderwick Chronicles.</p> 		<p>As mathematicians we will...</p> <p>be deepening our knowledge of multiplication. We will be investigating problems that involve multiplying 4 digits by 1- and 2-digit integers before moving on to dividing 4-digit integers by 1-digit.</p> 		<p>As scientists we will...</p> <p>describe how to use evaporation to recover a substance from a solution; demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible; and explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials and that this kind of change is not fully reversible.</p> 	
<p>As geographers we will...</p>  <p>use Google Earth and online maps to locate countries. We will look at ordnance survey symbols and how to use a six-figure grid reference.</p>		<p>Our focus skill for this term will be:</p>  	<p>Reading for Pleasure Class Novel:</p> 	<p>As technicians we will...</p> <p>learn how to control a simple circuit using a Sphero and then program a sequence of commands for it to follow, which includes a count-controlled loop. We will investigate loops and how they be repeated and stop when a condition is met.</p> 	
<p>As designers we will...</p> <p>research pulleys and then design, plan and create our own pulley systems which could be used in the design of a toy.</p> 		<p>Home Project</p> <p><i>We would love to see you and your child working together to create a family project.</i></p> <p>Projects could be: to plan a trip using a map and identifying symbols and timings, recording a route like a Sat Nav or creating their own using a key on a grid reference of a known place.</p> 		<p>In Religious Education we will...</p> <p>learn about what is important to Sikhs in Britain today and explore ways in which Sikhs express their faith and how their beliefs impact on their way of life.</p> 	
<p>As athletes we will...</p> <p>we will work in teams to create gymnastic routines to a variety of stimuli. We will also be looking at our hand eye co-ordination in dodgeball.</p> 		<p>As musicians we will...</p> <p>be learning the hip hop rap called, 'The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air'. Within this unit, children will focus on the pulse, rhythm and pitch of this piece of music.</p> 		<p>In PSHE we will...</p> <p>learning everything about our school value of Aspiration. The children will have a look at the aspirations of themselves and compare these to other children in different countries.</p>
