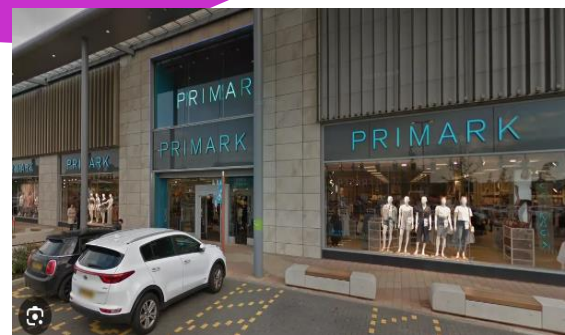

This is a very antique map of Rushden because it is black and white.

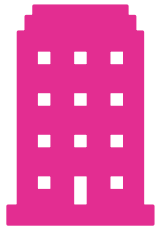
This is a very modern map of Rushden because it is in colour.

Lots of things have happened in the past so more people have come to live here, that's why there are more houses.

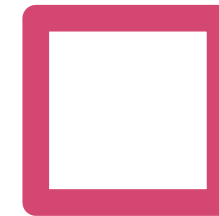

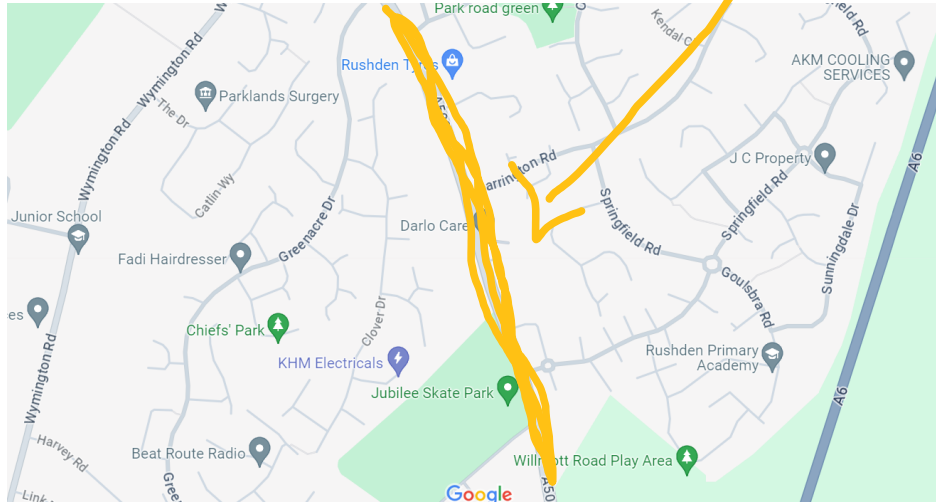
What is a listed building?

A listed building is a structure of particular architectural and/or historic interest deserving of special protection. Such buildings are placed on one of the four statutory lists maintained by Historic England in England.

Manor Farm House in Rushden was founded on the 9-DEC-1949 and used to be a working farm. It is a grade 2 listed building and like every listed building, it is vulnerable of falling down, which will bring sadness to Rushden.
