be exploring the changing seasons. We will learn about a range of different types of weather including cold, clouds and thunder. We will then discuss how to keep safe if there is a thunderstorm.




In Religious Education we will...

be exploring Joan Miro's artwork and practise similar techniques that he perfected using dough. Then using this new learning, we will create a sculpture of our own using clay.




Home project:
