

As writers we will...
 Learn how to write a wishing tale with a focus on dialogue. We will explore the work of Ted Hughes' Iron Man and create our own wishing tales. We will also learn how to write an explanation text.



As mathematicians we will...
 Learn how to multiply and divide with increasing difficulty. Revisit our place value understanding and then learn how to apply our knowledge of multiplication, division, addition, and subtraction to solve 2 step problems.



As scientists we will...
 learn how to: identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food. We will also learn how to identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.



As historians we will...
 Learn about ancient civilisations and the impact they had on our lives as we know it. We will begin to uncover what made Ancient Egyptians, Ancient Sumerians, The Indus Valley and The Shang Dynasty significant.

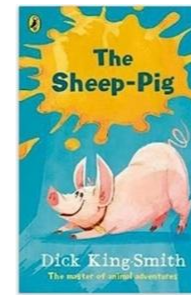

 Build a pyramid, present a news report about an ancient civilisation, create some artwork. Build a model.**

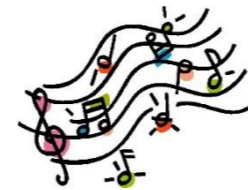


In Religious Education we will...
