

As writers we will...
write a narrative with dialogue to entertain the reader, focusing on re-writing an ending to *The Promise* by Nicola Davies. In the second half of the term, we will be writing a non-chronological report to inform the reader. We will use the book *Nile Crocodile* to support us.



As mathematicians we will...
be deepening our knowledge of multiplication. We will be investigating problems that involve multiplying 4 digits by 1- and 2-digit integers before moving on to dividing 4-digit integers by 1-digit. We will then move on to finding fractions of an amount and multiplying fractions.



As scientists we will...
describe how to use evaporation to recover a substance from a solution; demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible; and explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials and that this kind of change is not fully reversible.



As geographers we will...
use Google Earth and online maps to locate countries. We will look at ordnance survey symbols and how to use a six-figure grid reference. We will also delve into why we have different Time Zones across the Earth.

As technicians we will...
learn how to control a simple circuit using a crumble and then program a sequence of commands for it to follow, which includes a count-controlled loop. We will investigate loops and how they be repeated and stop when a condition is met.



As designers we will...
research pulleys, levers and gears. Children will then design, plan and create their own pulley systems, which could be used in the design of a toy.

We would love to see you and your child working together to create a family project. You could: plan a trip using a map, identifying and recording a route like a Sat Nav or creating a grid reference.



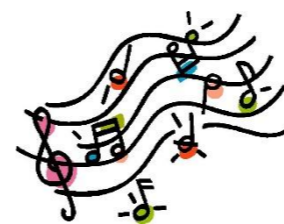
In Religious Education we will...
