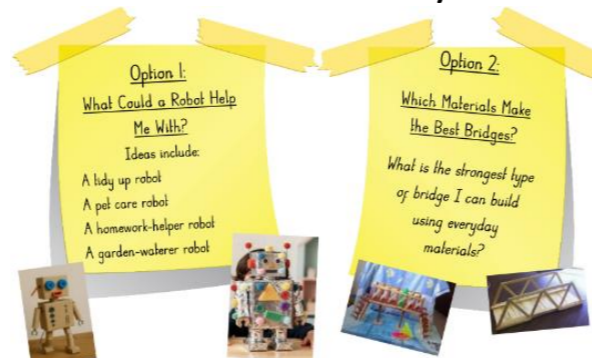
As technicians we will...
