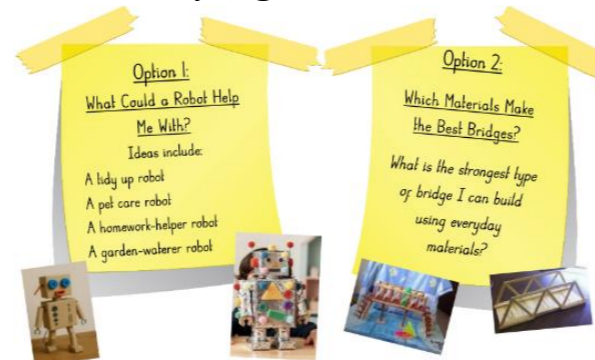
As technicians we will...

Science Home Project: See Miss Wibberley's guidance for this.



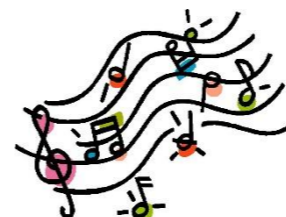
As historians we will...
