As writers we will...

be creating a newspaper report based on the book, 'Room 13.' We will be focusing on how to write to inform, as well as using direct and reported speech.



As mathematicians we will... be revising all our KS2 skills ahead of the SATs before embarking on a range of maths projects. These projects will be related to real life skills and knowledge such as budgeting, purchasing and employment.



As scientists we will... be learning about 'Blood and Transportation'. We will be able to describe the composition of blood and the functions of its components. We will understand how our body cares for our blood and the importance of bacteria for our health.

As technicians we will... be starting to explore and understand 3D modelling. We will use computers to create and manipulate 3D digital objects. We will create digital 3D designs based on a real-life object and develop an understanding that many objects are made up of a range of 3D shapes.



As artists we will...

be focusing on developing our printing skills. We will explore Islamic artwork and architecture considering the shapes, patterns and colours. Following this, we will create our own printing block to use and explore the skills of over printing.



Home Project:

To create your own human circulatory system using your knowledge of the heart, veins, arteries and capillaries from our science lesson. You could draw this, create it with red and blue string, use plasticine or any other material you like.



As historians we will... be continuing our learning of crime and punishment through the ages. We will focus on Anglo-Saxon times before looking at today's justice system and how it came to be. We will finish the unit with a visit from local magistrates who will conduct a mock trial.



As athletes we will...

be developing on our prior learning for Athletics and Fitness to be able to perform various new skills, whilst working collaboratively and individually to carry out a sequence and develop leadership.



As musicians we will... be listening to a range of songs sung by inspirational women in music. We will identify which instruments are used and compare musical features across similar songs. We will also learn how to describe the structure of a song.



In PSHE we will... be focusing on 'Relationships'. We will begin the unit by considering mental health and how to keep it healthy. We will reflect on online relationships before discussing the importance of love and loss.
