

The Pupil Council Rules

All Pupil Council members must:

- be respectful and listen to others
- contribute or participate actively in meetings
- follow the school rules and be role models to other pupils
- model good behaviour at all times
- be polite and courteous to others
- not refer to specific individuals or groups during discussions
- use their position on Pupil Council to support and develop their school and peers and not abuse this position in any way

Meetings:

Pupil council will meet every two weeks. These meetings will last a minimum of 30 minutes.

Should additional meetings be required, these will be called as necessary.

The venue and time of meetings will be agreed at the beginning of each school year.

For decisions to be made at a meeting, there must be at least 6 members present (one from each year group wherever possible) and decisions are made through a "show of hands" vote in which the majority rules.

Class / Year group meetings should be held once a month to discuss and share ideas and feedback. These should be included in class assembly time and circle time as appropriate
